

SAINTS NETBALL CLUB (SUNNYBANK) INC

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REGISTRATION AND FEE PAYMENT POLICY

Policy Statement:

Saints Netball Club (SNC) will ensure all players are registered and financial before the commencement of each season. No Player with outstanding monies from previous seasons will be accepted as a Player unless full restitution is made.

Implementation of the Policy:

Saints Netball Club will implement the policy as follows:

- ♣ Before the commencement of each season all players must register via NetballConnect.
- ♣ The Registration form and payment process must be completed online, prior to the commencement of each season (a cut off date will apply) to allow adequate time for processing, grading (where necessary) and team placement. Any registrations received after that may be considered after consultation with the SNC Executive Committee.
- → All fees for the season will be managed by the NetballConnect system via direct debit or credit/debit card. There is a pay in full option, and a pay by instalment option. The instalments will then be processed as per the schedule set each year against the nominated bank account/credit card. Any failed instalments payments will result in the player immediately becoming non-financial and therefore not able to play until recovery of failed instalment is received by SNC.
- Registration fees consist of 3 components
 - Netball Queensland Player insurance
 - MacGregor Netball Association (MNA) Facility hire for training, game days
 - Saints Netball Club (SNC) umpires, presentation event, award, equipment etc
- ♣ In the event that a player withdraws their registration prior to the grading process commencing:
 - For 11+ years, a full refund will be issued to the account or card used to register via NetballConnect
 - For Net Set Go players 7-10, the Net Set Go pack fee from Netball Australia will not be refunded
 if the players pack has been processed.

- ♣ Where a player withdraws their registration after the grading process has commenced, and before fixtures have commenced:
 - Netball Qld No refund is applicable for the Netball Queensland component as insurance has been initiated
 - MNA refund is at the discretion of MacGregor Management Committee
 - SNC will consider the request for a full or partial refund. If a refund is approved, funds will be refunded to the account or card used to register via NetballConnect. Funds will be refunded to the account or card used to register via NetballConnect.
- ♣ Where a player withdraws their registration after fixtures commence, no refund will be provided.
- → The Manager/Coach will check all Players are eligible to commence grading/playing from the membership list provided by the Registrar. For those not on this list, the Manager/Coach will refer them to the Registrar who will arrange for them to complete online registration immediately and contact the Treasurer and make them aware of fees payable.
- As well as a financial commitment to SNC each family (for each team member) must be willing to complete volunteer duties (Canteen, BBQ, Grounds, COVID duty) and assist in scoring and washing of bibs, when advised by the team manager. If you wished to be excused of these duties you must forward a written application to The Executive Committee, Saints Netball Club, saints-netballsbank@hotmail.com prior to the commencement of the season, stating your reason, as to why you should be excused.
- ➡ Training is an important process and players must have attended at least one training session before taking part in a fixtures game. It is the Player's/Parent's/Guardian's responsibility to inform the Coach/Manager if they are unable to attend training or a game. Parents must speak directly with the Coach/Manager before leaving a training session or game, even if it has been completed. This is to ensure the safety of Players.

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
